

Aquamaster Diamond

Who needs an Aquamaster Diamond?

The Aquamaster Diamond is a top of the range water filter, offering the user a wide choice of water filtering options to suit individual circumstances.

How can it save money?

Bottled water is one alternative to filtered water. With the most economic Diamond filter cartridges filtering 3000 to 5000 litres on depending on the cartridge type chosen per 6 months, this gives an approximate cost of 0.4pence per litre over one year. Even the most economic bottled water can't compete with that. The environment also benefits with less plastic bottles being made and disposed of.

What are the different types of filters available?

Diamond filter cartridges for 1 micron level filtration are available in two variations - basic (C10) and with limescale protection (BGSC).

Diamond filter cartridges for 5 micron level filtration are also available in two variations - basic (GC ABS) and with limescale protection (GSC ABS).

All cartridges filter out bacteria, THM's, organic pesticides, solvents, PAH's, turbidity, colour, taste, odour and chlorine. The 1 micron level cartridge also filters out cysts.

What results can I expect?

Tea will be better tasting without 'scummy' traces on the surface. Taste of water will improve and odour will diminish. You can be more confident in the health of the water, with bacteria and sediments filtered out.

How long does each filter last?

Each filter will keep filtering your drinking water for 3000 to 5000 litres on depending on the cartridge type chosen. UK water byelaws say that cartridges should be changed every 6 months to maintain the health of the water passing through. This is the industry recognised average lifespan. Salamander operate a free reminder service to prompt you to change the filter.



Can I fit it myself?

Yes, Aquamaster Diamond is simple to fit, it can be DIY fitted without the need to hire a plumber. For full fitting instructions, please view the 'Easy to fit' PDF. Aquamaster Diamond comes with all the necessary parts but you will need to be able to drill a hole in the work surface where the filter tap will be fitted.

How simple is it to refill?

Aquamaster Diamond is very simple to refill with no expertise needed. For refilling instructions, please view the 'Easy to fit' PDF. Refills can be bought on the website.

Other useful products

For more basic filtration needs consider using the Aquamaster Pearl or the Aquamaster Mini. The Aquamaster Pearl provides filtration down to 5 microns and comes with a full size chrome tap. The Aquamaster Mini provides filtration down to 10 microns and comes with a mini chrome tap.
